History of the Haverford Reserve

The former Haverford State Hospital closed in 1998. In 2002 the state sold the 209 acres to the Township for \$3.5 million. In 2006 the Township sold 40 acres to private development for \$17 million. Those proceeds funded the ball fields, the Dog Park, the trails and part of Freedom Playground and the Community Recreation and Environmental Center.
