






# 500/2025

- 500 miles by 2025 = on schedule for 2040
  - 325+ miles built to date
- Resolution Counts: 91 municipalities, 8 counties
  - 100th resolution coming soon!
- Resolutions build local enthusiasm, allow us to leverage support for county/state/fed funding




- The Circuit connects over 100 municipalities
  - But there are more than 350 in our region...
- TASCC: finding "low stress" on-road connections
- Advocating for towns to request bike lanes from PennDOT
- Most projects: signage of existing routes
