










In the past year, about how many times have you used a walking or biking trail, either nearby or somewhere else?




How often to you use one of the existing Township walking trails, such as the one in Veteran's Park?




If you don't normally use walking/biking trails, what is the biggest reason why not?




If there was a walking/biking trail nearby and convenient to use, how often do you think you would use it?






Radnor Township Open Space Network Plan 2015
