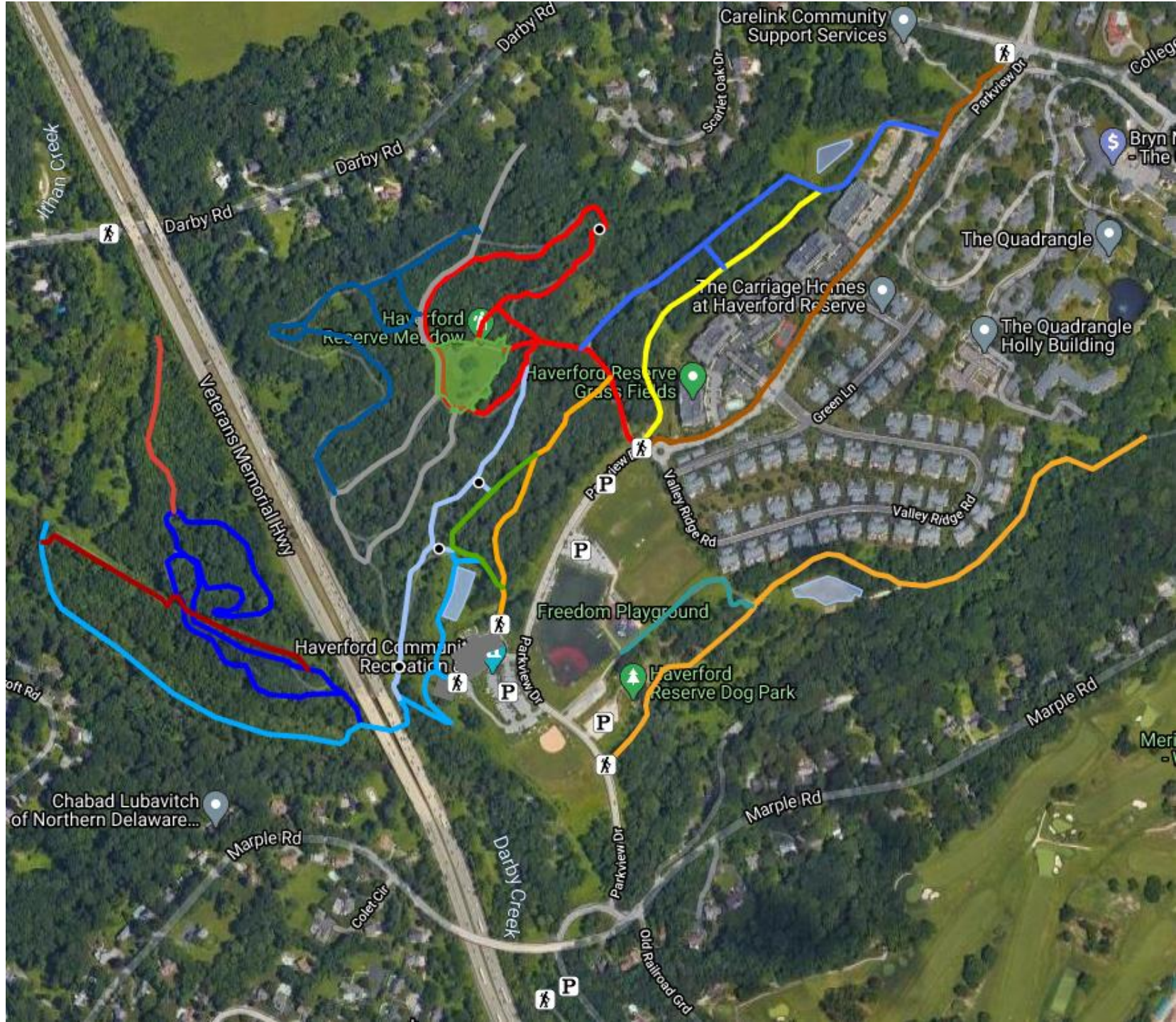

The Trails at Haverford Reserve

Improvements in 2020

- * Enhanced signage and trail markers on 7 miles of trails
- * New bridge on Meadow Trail
- * Planted over 150 trees along the trails and in open space
- * SWM work along Blue Route and Meadow trails – Installing water bars
- * Invasives removal



Darby Creek Trail Southern Extension

Darby Creek Trail – First Leg of trail was put in in 2013 from Merry Place to West Chester Pike. Funded by Grant from DVRPC

Township is planning adding ½ mile from Merry Place to Warrior Road.

Township is purchasing a home along this section to make way for trail.

Applied for construction grant from DVRPC.

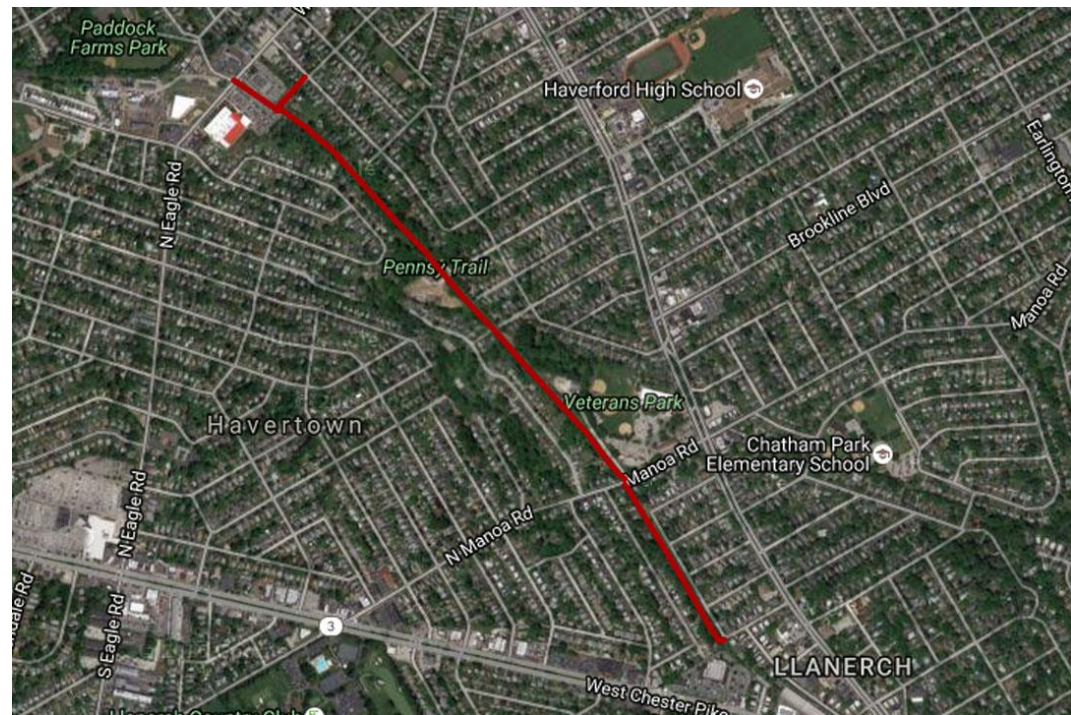


Pennsy Trail extension

- * Pennsy trail from Manoa Road to Darby Road along the old Newtown Square Rail line was installed In 2016 with a DVRPC grant.

- * Extension from Manoa Road to Llanerch Shopping Center on West Chester Pike scheduled to be completed in 2022.
Funded with a \$1,185,000 PennDot Grant

- * Pedestrian Bridge will be installed over Manoa Road
