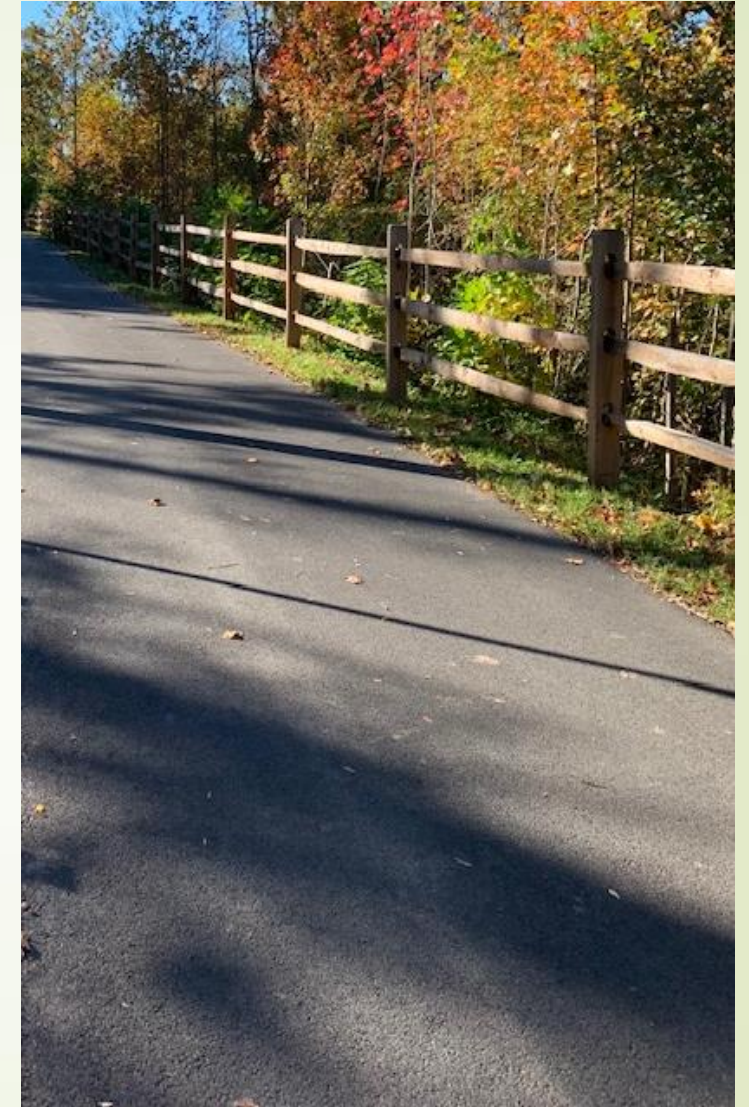




Radnor Township Trails & Greenways

- Funding from PennDOT, Dept. of Conservation & Natural Resources, Delaware County Green Ways Grant, DCED
- Radnor Funding 2019 Bond
- Easement from Radnor Township School District
- Easement from Penn Medicine
- Easement from Cornerstone HOA & Agreements for Stormwater Basin Access



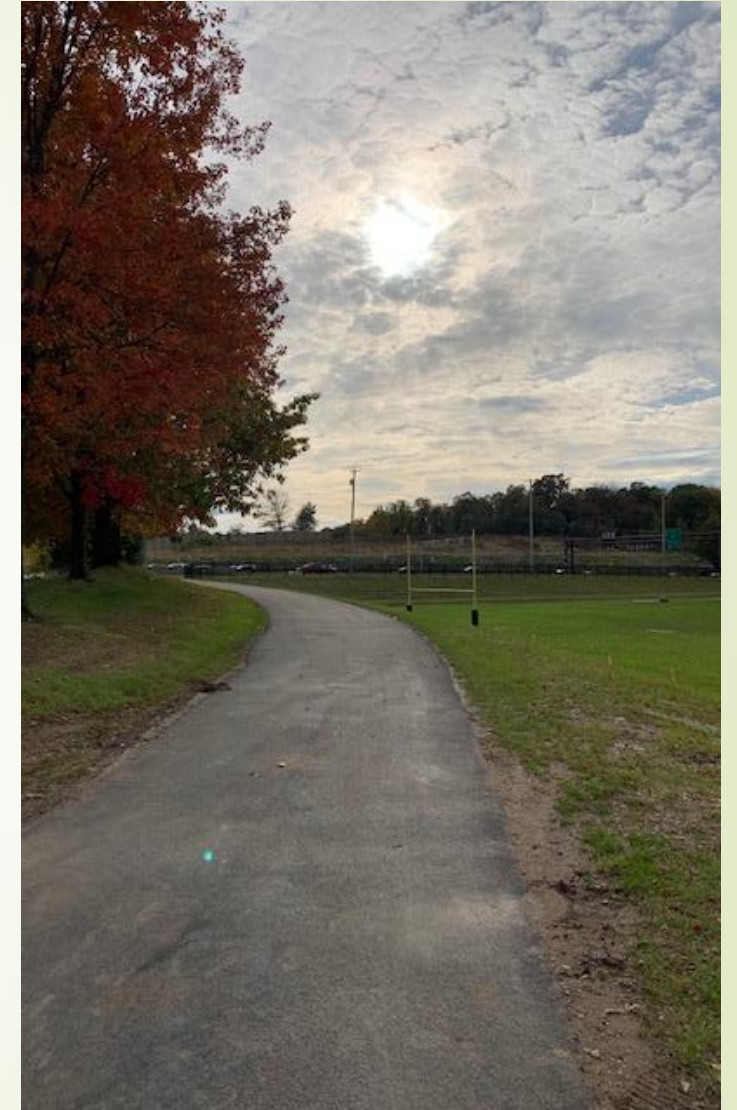
TAP Trail: Share the Road & Paved Trail

7.5 miles in total; 5 miles for walkers



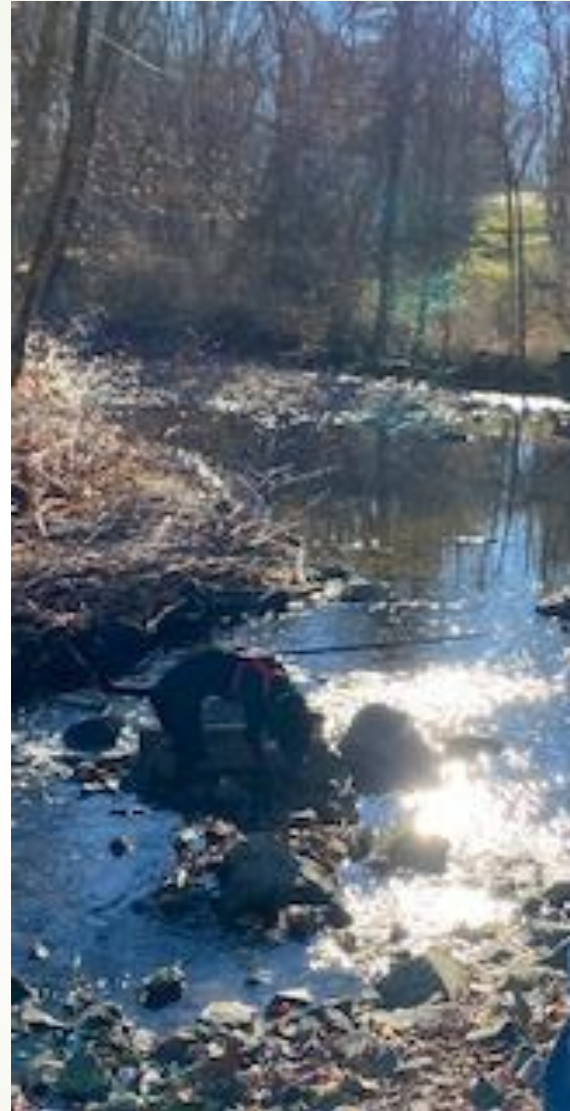
TAP Trail: Radnor High School Loop

- Radnor Chester Road
- King of Prussia Road
- 300 Trees & 193 Shrubs
- Stormwater Enhancements



TAP Trail: Bryn Mawr Avenue to Haverford Township

- ▶ For walkers accessible from Friends of Ithan Valley Park
- ▶ New Fence Installed in Cornerstone HOA Easement
- ▶ Paved Trail Ends at Haverford Township
- ▶ Blazed Trail to Darby Road



TAP Trail: West Wayne Avenue & Friends of Radnor Trail Park

- ▶ Sidewalk Replacement - East Side West Wayne Avenue
- ▶ 4ft Wide Sidewalk Beginning at Conestoga Road
- ▶ ADA Compliant Curb Ramps & Crosswalks Leading to Friends of the Radnor Trail Park.
- ▶ Allows for Radnor TAP Trail Walkers/Riders Safe Access to Friends of the Radnor Trail Park & Radnor Trail



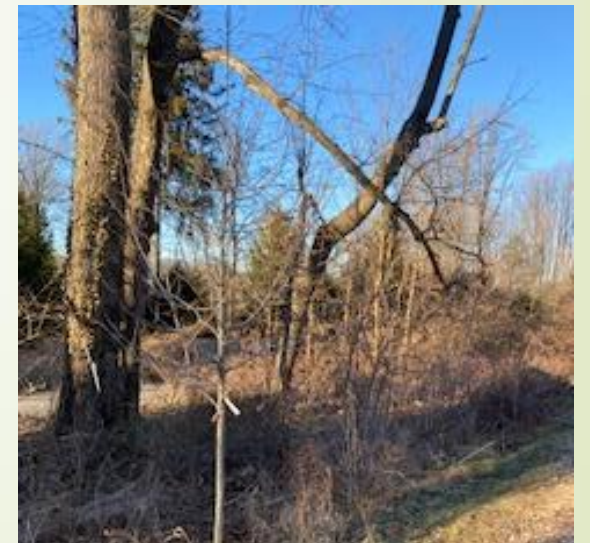
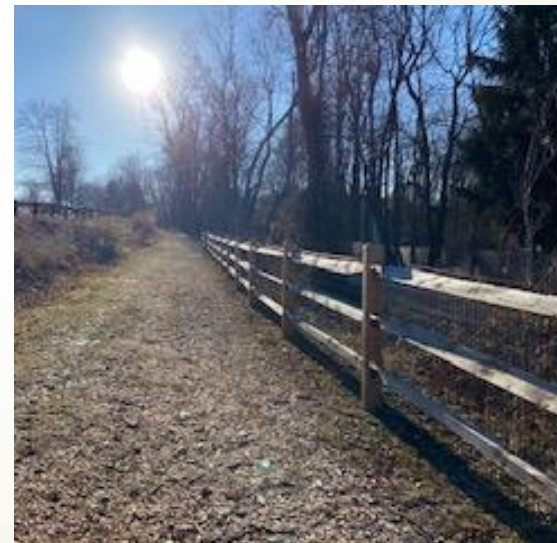
Radnor Multipurpose Trail Extension

- ▶ Phase II Rails to Trails
- ▶ Delaware County Greenways Grant Co-Sponsored by Radnor Township – \$407,000
- ▶ Extension Through Martha Browns Woods to Radnor Chester Road
- ▶ Extending the Existing 2.4 Mile Trail
- ▶ Currently Evaluating Soils and Testing



Harford Park Trail Extension

- ▶ Funded by 2019 Township Bond
- ▶ New Fence
- ▶ Tree Planting as Part of Shade Tree Commission Planting Program
- ▶ Connecting Harford Park and Radnor Elementary School/Radnor Corporate Center



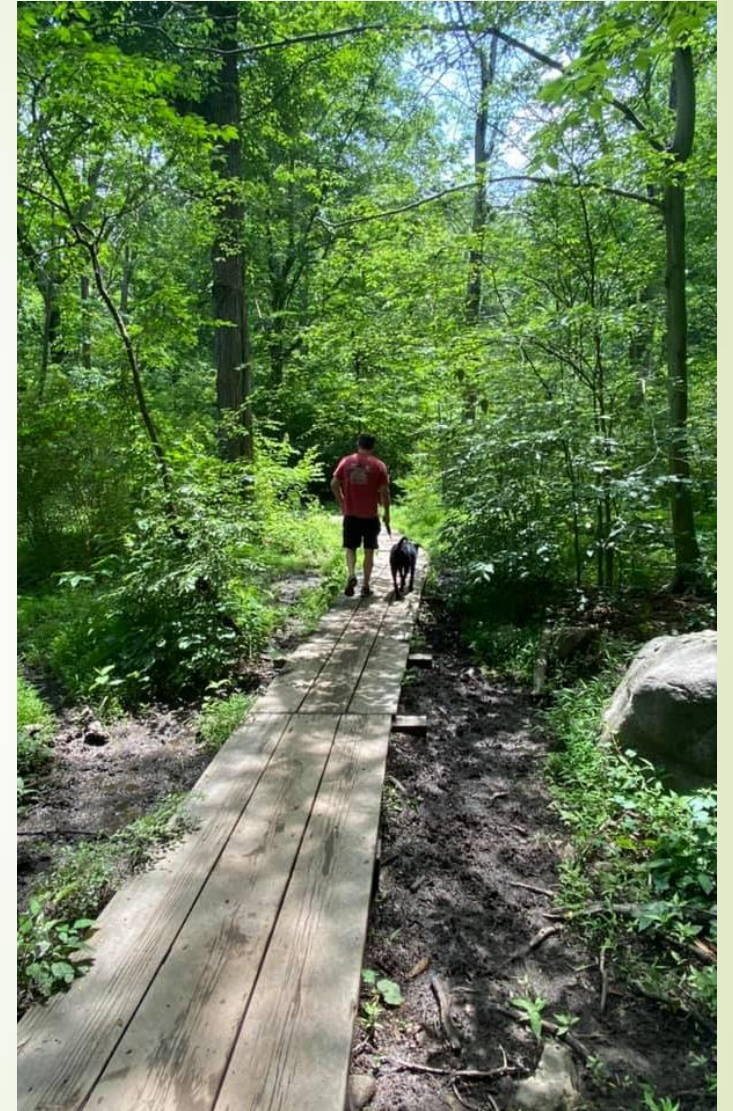
Saw Mill Park Accessibility Enhancements

- New Trees – Part of Shade Tree Commission-led Participation in the PHS Bare Root Tree Program



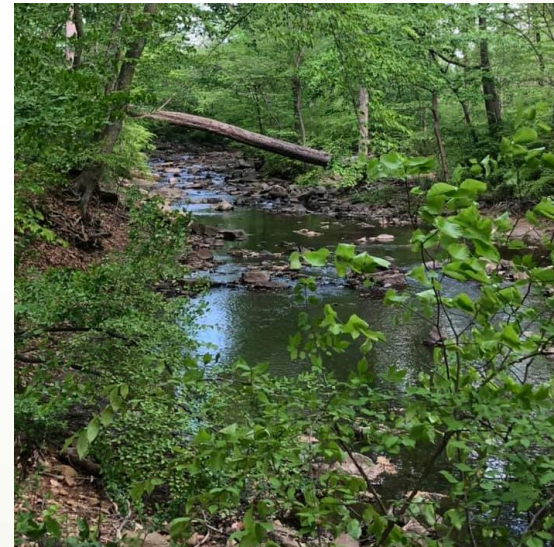
Willows & Skunk Hollow Tried & True
